



TestNav Log-In and Log-Out Instructions



Introduction

The purpose of this document is to provide students guidance on how to log into and out of TestNav8.




Steps	Screenshots
<p>Make sure the device is on the TestNav Sign In screen.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Look at your student testing ticket and make sure it has your first and last name on it. Raise your hand if you do not have your ticket.2. Enter your username and password as shown on your ticket.3. Selecting the eye icon to the right of the password will show / hide the password typed.4. Select the blue Sign In button.	 <p>The screenshot shows the TestNav login interface. You may look back at the passage or passages when needed.</p> <p>To answer a question that asks you to pick one answer, select one answer from the answer choices.</p> <p>To answer a question that asks you to pick more than one answer, select your answers from the answer choices.</p> <p>If you do not know the answer to a question, you may flag it and go on.
